AUCKLAND UNITED F.C. ACADEMY OVERVIEW

Auckland United Academy is a 4-Term Development Programme for Elite Footballers.

The Academy Programme is for Boys U9 - U17 & Girls U10 - U16.

Players who are successful in joining the Academy, commit to the annual development programme and therefore play club football for Auckland United F.C. We also offer part-time training options for players who are currently attached to other clubs.

The annual training programme consists of:

- 3 4 Academy Trainings per week
- Four Term Annual Training Programme (30 38 weeks)
- Delivered by Professional Coaches (Qualified & Approved by NZF)
- Academy Holiday Camps
- Proven Player Development Pathway & Philosophy

*Additional specialised training programmes will also be on offer throughout 2021, including the 'Individual Development Programme' which is led by Academy Director and Womens Development Manager: Hiroshi Miyazawa and Mauro Donoso respectively.

Auckland United has made a positive start with the New Zealand Football Club licensing programme.

In 2020, AUFC received accreditation for its Skill Centre Programme (U9-U12), Talent Development Program (U13-U17), and a National League Licence for the revised league proposal to start in the summer of 2021.

The successful accreditations place the Football Club among a very select number of clubs, nationally, who have achieved these accreditations and ensure our player pathway is as strong as possible.
